## **Description**

Lviv. St. Mary Magdalene Church

The building of the present Lviv Organ Hall (the former Roman Catholic Church of St. Mary Magdalena) was built between 1600 and 1612 by Dominican monks outside the city fortifications, on the site of an old wooden temple. The church was built in the middle of the XVIII century, and the modern completion of the towers temple acquired in the last third of the nineteenth century.

As a result of two construction stages, the church presents a three-stage six-column basilica with an elongated altar and faceted apse. Renaissance features are combined with baroque and neo-Baroque elements (tower helmets).

In the 1960s, the building was adapted for the organ hall of the Lviv Conservatory named after Mykola Lysenko. The concerts are performing here and lectures about music, and art gallery works. Recently, under a layer of soviet whitewashing, was found a valuable fresco of the 1930s (artist Jan Henryk Rosen). Lviv Organ Hall is one of the key concert halls in Lviv — which can accommodate up to 400 listeners. This is a concert hall focused on multi-genre and diversity, on the versatility of concert programs.
