Pidhirtsi. Basilian Monastery

Pidhirtsi Monastery is a Basilian male monastery in the village of Pidhirtsi in Lviv region. It belongs to the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church. This is an architectural monument of the XVIII century. It's located in the valley among the forests. Above the monastery is the famous settlement Plisnesko - the remains of an ancient city mentioned in the Chronicle of Rus' under 1188 year, as well as in the "Word of Igor's Regiment".

In 1946, the Basilian monastery was liquidated, all the monks (fathers and brothers) were arrested and exiled by the decision of the soviet authorities and Monastery was turned into a tuberculosis sanatorium.

In 1989, for the first time since its closure, the Church celebrated the Christmas Divine Liturgy. Today, as throughout its history, Pidhirtsi or, as it has long been called, the Plisnesko Monastery attracts many pilgrims.
