Description Lviv. St. George's Cathedral

The Greek Catholic Archicatedral Cathedral of St. George is a majestic shrine built in the XVIII century that dominates the high highlands over Lviv, beautifully combined with the urban landscape. The Cathedral is built in the style of the lush Baroque, part of the project by Bernard Meretin, and decorated with a monumental sculpture by the outstanding sculptor Johan Pinzel.

Since 1998, the Cathedral, along with the *Ensemble of the Historical Center of Lviv*, is assigned as an *UNESCO World Heritage Site*. The Cathedral itself (1745-1770), is part of the complex, which includes the bell tower built in the nineteenth century with the bell dating back to 1341, metropolitan chamber (1761-1762), houses of the capitol, terrace with courtyard stairs, openwork fence around the courtyard with two gates (1771), walls around capital houses, and the metropolitan gardens (1772).

In the underground part of the Cathedral - the crypt - there are sarcophagi of the most prominent figure of the Greek Catholic Church, Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky and other hierarchs.

In the soviet period, by the decision of the Lviv Council of 1946, where the abolition of the Union of Brest was decided, the Council passed with the property to the Russian Orthodox Church. Only on April 6, 1990, by the decision of the Lviv City Council, the St. George's Cathedral was again transferred to the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church.
