Description Lviv. Citadel

Lviv Citadel is a fortification in the city center. The citadel was built during 1852-54 and according to the blueprint it consists of four (4) round towers and a V-shaped barrack building. All round towers were cannon towers and were built according to the system proposed by Austrian General Maximilian-Joseph d'Este (such buildings replaced traditional bastions and were called Maximilian towers).

This interesting and kind of unique fortification has become a "tourist magnet" not only for residents but also for guests of the city – it offers a wonderful lookout view of downtown.

During the battles in November 1918, the Citadel housed Ukrainian artillery, who fired at enemy positions from a tower's height. During the Second World War, the Stalag-328 concentration camp was organized here. In 1943 in addition to the red army war prisoners, its prisoners were Italian soldiers.
