## **Description Lviv. Modern City Hall**

Lviv City Hall is the main administrative building on the city central square. Its history dates back to the XIVcentury. The first Town hall was a half wooden structure, the second, with a masonry tower, was built at the end of the XV century. It was repeatedly reconstructed after fires, and it stood until 1826, when it finally burn eddown during the revolutionary events of 1848. Then, a modern reconstructed building a ppeared.

Today it is the residence of the Lviv City Council. One of the accents of the central part of the city, which is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Although in aesthetic terms this object does not attract such attention as other buildings of the city center, thetown hall has become one of the iconic monuments of Lviv due to the role it played in historical events.

After the collapse of the Austro-Hungarian Empire in 1918, new nation-states began to be created in its former territories. The Ukrainians of Galicia chose Lviv as their capital, and it is symbolic that it was on the tower of the city hall – the highest tower of Ukraine – that on November 1, 1918, a yellow and blue flag was hoisted.

And although the newly created West Ukrainian People's Republic did not last long, the experience gained through those years was given to the creation of an independent Ukraini

an state in 1991, during the agony of the USSR.

In the years leading up to the 1991 independence, there was considerable fear and risk. L viv was being watched by the entire then Soviet Ukraine. The capital of Galicia became t he inspiration for the nationalrevival. It was in Lviv, a little more than a year before the proclamation of state independence, that the blueand yellow flag was raised over the City H all. On April 3, 1990, thousands of people gathered in the mainsquare of the city. People, seeing the national flag on the tower, cried with inspiration and admiration. Lviv wasthen one of the first in Ukraine to proclaim its national position.

In the XV-XX centuries, a city trumpeter served on the tower of the city hall. He had to monitor the security of the city around the clock, notify the exact time with a signal, play s olemn music on holidays, and sound thealarm in the event of an enemy attack or fire. The tradition of playing trumpet at the Lviv City Hall was revived in 2011.
