Description Olesko Castle

Olesko Castle is an architectural and history monument of the XIII-XVIII centuries, located in Olesko, Zolochiv district, Lviv region. For the first time Olesko Castle is mentioned in written sources dating from 1327. It is probably built by one of the sons of the Galician-Volyn Prince Yuri Lvovych on

the plateau of the hill, which rises among the floodplain of the Libertsiy River. The building has been standing on a hill for more than six centuries and has witnessed many historical events, suffered from raids by Tatars and suffered fire damage.

In 1590, extensive construction works began, which were accelerated after the merge of two noble families - Zholkevski and Danilovich, originally Orthodox Ukrainian. In the 1630s in the service of Zholkevsky was Mikhail Khmelnytsky, the father of Bogdan Khmelnitsky, whose young years passed in Olesko.

Back in the days of Danilovich in 1629, Ivan Danilovich's grandson, the future Polish King Jan III Sobieski, who received the castle in 1682, was born in the Olesko castle. In the middle of the XVIII century Revussky (Rzevuski) owned Olesko Castle and he turned the place into a luxurious palace with a park.

In 1838, because of an earthquake, the castle was badly damaged and eventually turned into a ruin.

In the 1930s the castle was restored. However, the fire of 1951 negated restoration results. In 1961, at the initiative of the chief architect of the Lviv region Andriy Shulyar, new fundamental restoration works began. In December 1975, the castle opened its doors as a museum. Since then, it has been a branch of the Lviv Art Gallery (now the Lviv National Art Gallery named after B.G. Voznitsky, called the Museum-Reserve "Olesko Castle").
