Description Lviv. Zhovkva Suburb

Long before the 1800's the territory which is considered as the city Lviv previously was surrounded by a wall (perimetre measureing — 1700 m, height — 8 m, thickness — 2 m, with fortified towers located every 60 m). On the exterior a deep moat and an earthen rampart was present. Today, this territory is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List under the name "Ensemble of the Historical Center of Lviv".

Inside this city Ukrainian, Armenian, and Jewish settlements were formed, where mostly representatives of the corresponding nationalities grouped. With the advent of new methods of warfare, when the need for fortress cities disappeared, the Austrian authorities ordered to dismantle the walls around Lviv. Thus, new areas for development were formed.

Previously under Austria, in 1871 Lviv regained the right of city self-government. The city administratively allocated Seredmistia (central part) and 4 suburbs — territories subordinated to the Lviv Magistrate: Zhovkivske, Krakowske, Lychakivske and Halytske. The Zhovkva suburb was located north of the historic center of Lviv, behind the former Krakow gate. It occupied the territories that previously were part of the Krakow suburbs, as well as the far northern regions, which were once called Havrylivka, and today - Pidzamche. Now it is Shevchenkivskyi district of Lviv.
